EXPLANATION OF AWARDS

The New Life Deliverance Temple Church Community Scholarship is awarded to graduating high school seniors in Okaloosa or Santa Rosa County. Each applicant must be a member in good standing of a local church and must maintain a 2.0-4.0 GPA upon graduation. Applicants must also show that they have been active in their community and extracurricular activities within their school. Applicants must have been accepted to a college or university before funds are disbursed. Funds will be given to the school in the student's name and not paid directly to the student.

Awards are given on three levels:

The Mark A. Williams Community Scholarship is awarded to students who possess a 2.0 – 2.9 GPA.

The Brenda M. Williams Community Scholarship is awarded to students who possess a 3.0 – 3.4 GPA.

The Michelle W. Hill Community Scholarship is awarded to students who possess 3.5 or greater GPA.

The committee will decide the number of each scholarship to be awarded based upon the availability of funds. The amount of scholarship award depends on the applicants' GPA with higher amounts awarded for higher GPA's.

The awards and recognition ceremony will be held in May 2025.
